

# Fire Safety At Work

## Introduction

It is a legal requirement for employers to provide information, instruction and training about fire safety in the workplace (Fire Safety Regulations - The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005).

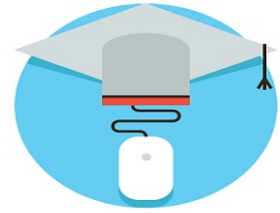
